*The visible reality that we see in the sacraments is their outward expression, the form they take, and the way in which they are administered and received

*The invisible reality we cannot “see” is God’s grace, his gracious initiative in redeeming us through the death and Resurrection of his son.

3 Sacrament Groups

***Initiation**: Baptism, Eucharist, Confirmation

***Healing**: Reconciliation, Anointing of the Sick

***Service of Communion**: Matrimony and Holy Orders

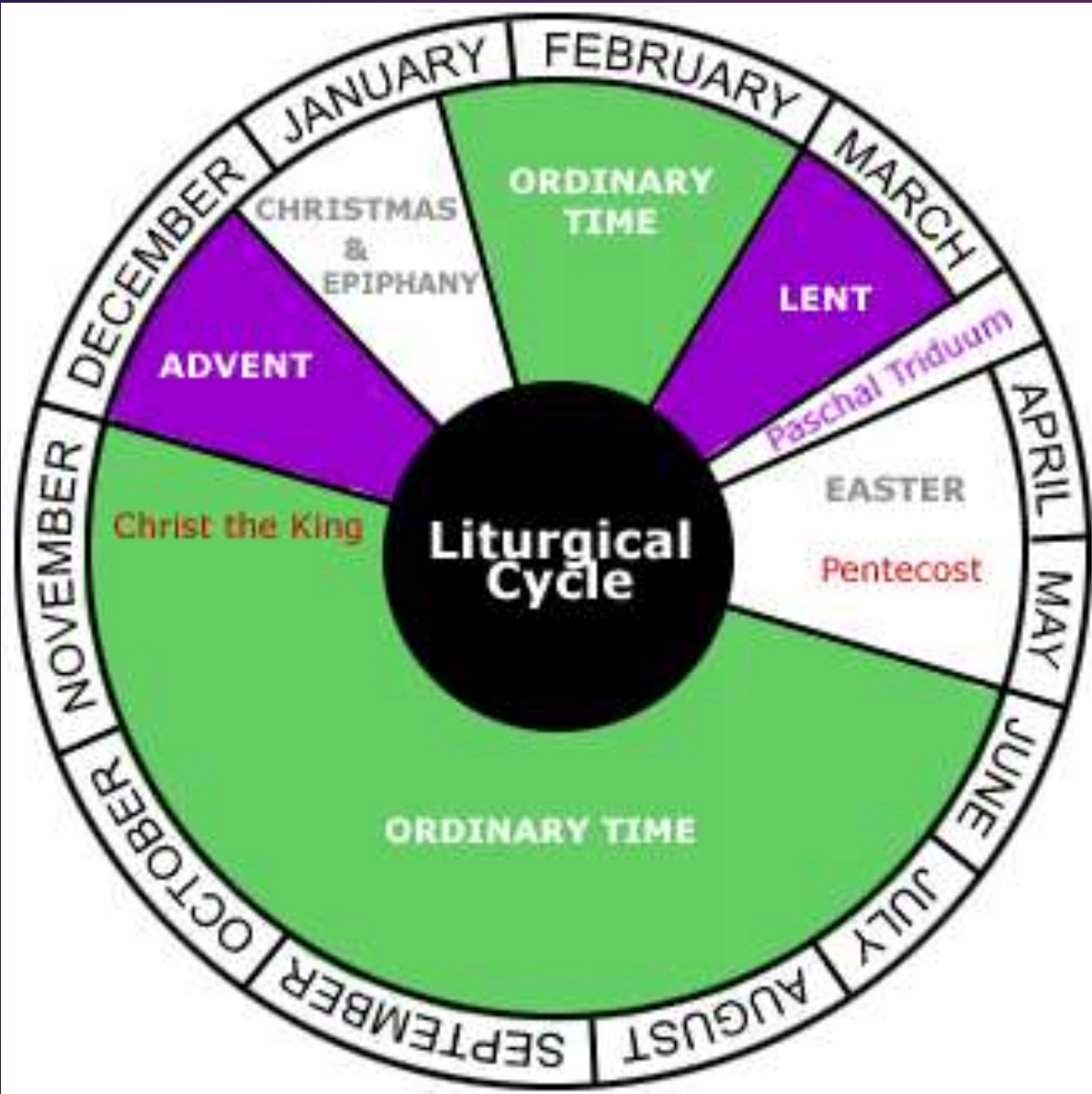

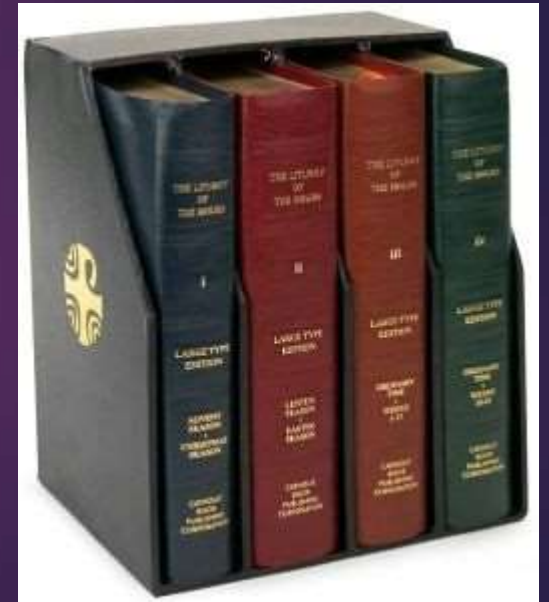
